What is the impact of the Neighbourhood Action Strategy?


That is the question the Hamilton Neighbourhoods Study asks.

This study is a survey of residents in McQuesten. The survey includes questions on: housing & physical environment, community, safety & security, civic engagement, health, employment, and education & demographics.


McQuesten is the neighbourhood stretching from Parkdale Avenue North to the Red Hill Valley Parkway and Queenston Road to the

CNR tracks.












